

Cable CPR Ratings

Are you aware of the importance of
cable CPR* Ratings?

Every cable sold should have a label like this:



- The label declares the CPR rating of the cable – in this case *CPR Cca*;
- The only exception is Fire Cable, but these may also be included within the next few years;
- There are five levels of CPR ratings, *Fca* being the lowest, *B2ca* the highest;
- Since Grenfell, the move is towards all cables in public buildings being a minimum rating of *CPR Cca*;
- If the wrong cable is installed, the implications are likely to be massive. Inspectors could demand the cable be ripped out and re-installed if it is not to the correct standard.
